PCR Testing

There are two forms of this testing available. We can deliver on-site testing, complete with a nurse to help conduct and support the process. We also have a home test available, which employees administer to themselves and send to the lab via FedEx. Both tests reveal results within 48-72 hours of being sent to the lab.

This includes daily screening in combination with COVID-19 testing. Testing can be completed for an entire workforce prior to returning to the workplace or as needed based on individual screening results. A nurse can be present to recommend next steps and guide employees.

Screening + Testing + Quarantine Program

Screening and testing capabilities can be paired with a Quarantine Program, managed in partnership with your Human Resources Department, to help guide employees through the next steps of their care if they test positively for COVID-19 or exhibit symptoms in the workplace.

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FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What kind of COVID-19 testing is available?

The PCR swab test confirms active COVID-19 infection and risk of spread.

Is this testing program covered by my insurance?

Rules and regulations vary by state and insurance plan. We'll work with you every step of the way to determine the best solution.

Is this testing program something that I can deduct on my taxes?

Consult your accountant or financial team for their advice. We'll provide any documentation needed, as well as connect them to our financial experts.

How long do results take?

Test results are available in 48-72 hours after being received by the lab.

How long will an employee who tests positive be out of work?

Return to work is predicated on a negative test result after a 10-day quarantine, assuming symptom improvement (if present) and remaining symptom-free for at least 72 hours prior to the repeat test.

How long does it take to set up a testing process?

There is a 4-week turnaround for on-site set-up (from time of request and the final agreement being signed).

How much time out of the workday will this process take?

Our goal is to limit downtime and safely get your team back to work. Once the process has been established, generally a 15-minute time period in the morning (per employee) will be all that is necessary.

Which testing plan is best for my company?

Much like the products you sell and the employees who work for you, no two companies are alike. We can offer our expert recommendations and walk you through the process with our expert sales team.

Do these plans have any scalability?

Yes. We offer options every step of the way.

How long will I need a testing program?

While no one is certain when a vaccine or antibodies will be available, we would recommend having some level of testing and screening for at least the next 12-18 months.
